ENTRY PROCEDURE

The number of entries and number of qualifying heats is limited. During the process of submitting entries and forming of entry lists for each event, entry times will be taken into consideration.

In case the swimmers are preliminary entered with no entry times (NT) and the number of entries exceeds the maximum number of entries for that particular event, swimmers with entry times will have the priority over swimmers with no entry times.

In case swimmers do not have entry times a draw will be conducted in order to determine which swimmer is to be included into the entry lists.

The organizer holds the right to increase or decrease the maximum number of qualifying heats after the entry deadline has passed in order to ensure efficient course of the competition



COMPETITION PROGRAM & SEEDING

Competition program for A, B & C category competitors consists of morning heats and afternoon finals. Heats are to be swum in all individual events except for 400m individual medley, 800m and 1500m freestyle events.

In those events swimmers are being distributed in heats according to their entry times (competitors with best entry times will be swimming in the final heat of each event). Number of heats and seeding in other individual events will be determined in accordance with WA swimming rules (SW 3.1.).

In case there are less than 16 competitors entering the event, heats will be swum to determine lane placing in A and B finals. In case there are not more than 8 competitors entering the event, they will proceed directly to finals. Slower heats of 400m individual medley, 800m and 1500m freestyle will be swum during the morning heats. Fastest heats of those events will be swum in the afternoon finals.

Competition program for D, E & F category competitors consists of direct finals for each individual event – swimmers are being distributed in heats according to their entry times (competitors with best entry times will be swimming in the final heat of each event). Flying start will be used during the course of the competition.





A&B FINALS

Finals are planned for all individual events. All finals will take place in the afternoon sessions. A and B Finals are opened for all competitors regardless of age. B Finals will be swum in all 50m and 100m events and in 200m freestyle event for both men and women. B Finals will precede A finals.

WITHDRAWALS FROM A&B FINALS

Withdrawals are to be made not later than 30 minutes after official announcement of the results from the heats.



AWARDS

Top three ranked competitors in each individual event will be awarded with medals. Criteria for determining the best A, B & C category male and female competitor of the meet is the sum of two best performances from two different events according to WA 2024 Points Table achieved in the heats or in the finals.

It is mandatory for individuals who wish to compete for the title of the best competitor of the meet to swim in the finals for which they manage to qualify. Top three male and female A category competitors (Open) will receive 500/250/125-euro prize money if they manage to score a total of more than 1600 WA 2024 points from two different events.

Best male and female competitors within B and C category are going to be awarded with a trophy and a gift. One boy and one girl (D and E category together) with the largest total of points from 400m freestyle and 200m individual medley events according to WA 2024 Points Table are going to be awarded with a trophy and a gift.

The best team will be awarded with a trophy according to medal standings.



AWARDING CEREMONIES

The medals will not be presented to the medal winners on the podium. The medal winners will have the opportunity to collect the medals by themselves at the medal pickup point designated by the organizer after the conclusion of each individual event.

Medals for A, B and B&C category medal winners will be available after the conclusion of A and B finals of the afternoon sessions (see the Competition Program) and will take into account only the results achieved in the afternoon finals. In case there are not enough competitors from B category in A or B finals, next fastest result from the morning heats is going to be taken into consideration.

Medals for C category will available after the conclusion of heats in the morning sessions based upon the results achieved in the heats (see the Competition Program).

Medals for D, E & F category medal winners will be available after the conclusion of each individual event of the competition program for those categories.

Awards for best competitors and the best teams will be performed at the end of the meet in the space designated by the organizer.



VERY IMPORTANT INFORMATIONS

- The Event is being organized in accordance with Law on Sports in the Republic of Serbia, Competition Rules and other Rules and Regulations made by Serbian swimming Federation. In case there are issues not covered by Competition Rules of this Event and also Competition Rules and other Regulations made by Serbian swimming Federation, WA Rules on swimming and other WA Rules and Regulations will be aplied.

– All competitors willing to participate, regardless of age and gender, must have no health issues whatsoever. They have to be completely healthy and capable of competing in accordance with Law on determining general health and ability to engage in sports and recreational activities.

– Teams and competitors who officially enter the competition will be held responsible for all legal and financial issues regarding health of individual athletes regardless of age, gender or category.
